NAVPHIL 140/20 – LUZON, E. COAST, OFF CATANDUANES IS. – MISSING PERSONS

THIRTEEN (13) FISHERMEN WERE REPORTED MISSING ON 26 OCTOBER 2020 AFTER THEIR VESSELS CAPSIZED DUE TO TYPHOON QUINTA (INTERNATIONAL NAME: MOLAVE). THE INCIDENTS WERE REPORTED OFF THE FOLLOWING AREAS IN CATANDUANES ISLAND:
