## MESSAGE

### **NAVPHIL 054/20 – MINDANAO, NE. COAST, SURIGAO DEL NORTE – PORT CLOSURE**

**IN CONNECTION TO THE PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION NO. 922 DECLARING A STATE OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY THROUGHOUT THE PHILIPPINES AND SURIGAO DEL NORTE EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 20-009, ALL PORTS IN THE PROVINCE OF SURIGAO DEL NORTE WILL IMPLEMENT THE FOLLOWING RULES:**

- 1. ENTRY OF FOREIGN VESSELS WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL WATERS OF THE PROVINCE OF SURIGAO DEL NORTE IS SUSPENDED EFFECTIVE 18 TO 31 MARCH 2020.**
- 2. ENTRY OF PASSENGER VESSELS COMING FROM CEBU CITY WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL WATERS OF THE PROVINCE OF SURIGAO DEL NORTE IS SUSPENDED EFFECTIVE 18 TO 31 MARCH 2020.**
- 3. VESSELS COMING FROM THE PROVINCE OF DINAGAT ISLANDS WILL BE ALLOWED TO DOCK AT THE PHILIPPINE PORTS AUTHORITY (PPA) BASEPORT IN SURIGAO CITY AND VESSELS COMING FROM THE PROVINCE OF LEYTE WILL BE ALLOWED TO DOCK AT LIPATA FERRY TERMINAL.**

**ALL SHIPS/WATERCRAFTS ARE ADVISED TO TAKE NOTE OF THE INFORMATION AND ABIDE BY THE RULES SET BY THE PHILIPPINE GOVERNMENT TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID19.**

**MASTERS OF VESSELS WISHING TO CALL AT SURIGAO DEL NORTE ARE ADVISED TO READ THE FULL TEXT OF SURIGAO DEL NORTE EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 20-009 AND CONTACT THE PORT AUTHORITIES IN SURIGAO DEL NORTE FOR FURTHER GUIDANCE.**
