## MESSAGE

### **NAVPHIL 055/20 – VISAYAS ISLANDS, CEBU ISLAND – PORT CLOSURE**

**IN CONNECTION TO THE PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION NO. 922 DECLARING A STATE OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY THROUGHOUT THE PHILIPPINES AND CEBU PROVINCE EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 5-F, ALL TRAVELERS ARRIVING IN ALL PORTS WITHIN THE PROVINCE OF CEBU WILL BE DENIED ENTRY FROM 14 MARCH 2020 TO 12 APRIL 2020. PUBLIC OFFICIALS, MEMBERS OF THE MILITARY, POLICE OFFICERS, HEALTH PERSONNEL ON OFFICIAL BUSINESS ARE EXCLUDED FROM THE TRAVEL RESTRICTION.**

**THE DELIVERY OF CARGO AND SUPPLIES ENTERING CEBU WILL NOT BE IMPEDED. HOWEVER, CREW OF VESSELS AND DELIVERY PERSONNEL WILL BE SUBJECTED TO APPLICABLE HEALTH AND QUARANTINE PROTOCOLS.**

**ALL SHIPS/WATERCRAFTS ARE ADVISED TO TAKE NOTE OF THE INFORMATION AND ABIDE BY THE RULES SET BY THE PHILIPPINE GOVERNMENT TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID19.**

**MASTERS OF VESSELS WISHING TO CALL AT ANY PORT IN CEBU PROVINCE ARE ADVISED TO READ THE FULL TEXT OF CEBU PROVINCE EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 5-F AND CONTACT THE PORT AUTHORITIES FOR FURTHER GUIDANCE.**
