
MESSAGE

NAVPHIL 058/17 – PALAWAN, W. COAST, PALAWAN PASSAGE – PIRACY

AN OFFSHORE TUG UNDERWAY WAS CHASED BY TWO (2) SPEED BOATS. MASTER INCREASED SPEED, CONDUCTED EVASIVE MANOUVRES AND ACTIVATED FIRE HOSES. INCIDENT REPORTED TO PHILIPPINE AUTHORITIES. VESSEL MANAGED TO ESCAPE AND CREW ARE SAFE. THE INCIDENT HAPPENED AT THIS POSITION:

10° 58'N., 118° 15'E.
