- B. TURN ON THEIR AIS TRANSMITTER AT ALL TIMES AND ENSURE IT EMITS THE CORRECT INFORMATION AS TO VESSEL SPECIFICATIONS AND NAME OF OWNER.**
- C. AVOID ENTERING OYSTER BAY WHICH IS AN EXCLUSION AREA FOR MILITARY USE ONLY**
