With the implementation of the NAMRIA Open Data Policy, the new and updated geospatial information categorized as open data produced by the agency were uploaded to the NAMRIA website and the GP. These are available for access/downloading by the stakeholders and the general public. It is noted that the updated land cover maps and topographic maps, which are used in change detection and analysis, had the greatest number of downloads. Further, the Lot Plotter and Map Viewer were the most accessed features of the GP.</p>

Among the 558 respondents, the private sector dominated as 43.91% of the clients are private companies and 24.45% are private individuals. The academia follows at 13.08%. The national government (environment and natural resources sector) is at 6.27% and the national government (other sectors) account for 3.41%. The local government units represent the 6.63% and the government-controlled corporations represent the 0.36%. The other respondents are from the non-government organizations at 0.36% and foreign entities at 0.54%.
