d. Two (2) recent **Individual Performance Commitment and Review (IPCR)** Form or its equivalent (for government employees); and

e. Other **Application Documents**:

e.3) Authenticated Certificate of Eligibility issued by the CSC or CESB (as needed);

e.5) College Diploma and Transcript of Records (TOR);

e.6) Service Record (for government employees); and

6. The Scanned documentary requirements submitted shall only be used for the position applied for. A maximum of three (3) positions can be applied by the applicants.

7. The submitted application documents (hard and electronic copies) shall be solely used for recruitment purposes and shall be **retained** for a period of **one (1) year**; afterwards, they shall be disposed of in accordance with applicable laws and office regulations.
