NAVPHIL 045/20 – PANAY, E. COAST, ILOILO CITY – PORT CLOSURE

IN CONNECTION TO THE PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION NO. 922 DECLARING A STATE OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY THROUGHOUT THE PHILIPPINES AND ILOILO CITY EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 050, ALL THE PORTS IN ILOILO WILL IMPLEMENT THE FOLLOWING RULES:

- 1. ALL PASSENGERS TRAVELLING BY SEA FROM METRO MANILA, BATANGAS PORT, AND COUNTRIES IDENTIFIED BY THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION (WHO) AS COUNTRIES WITH CONFIRMED CASES OF COVID19 SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER ILOILO CITY FROM 16 MARCH 2020 TO 14 APRIL 2020.**
- 2. ALL CREW MEMBERS OF PASSENGER VESSELS, CARGO VESSELS, OR OTHER VESSELS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO DISEMBARK FROM 16 MARCH 2020 TO 14 APRIL 2020.**

ALL SHIPS/WATERCRAFTS ARE ADVISED TO TAKE NOTE OF THE INFORMATION AND ABIDE BY THE RULES SET BY THE PHILIPPINE GOVERNMENT TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID19.

MASTERS OF VESSELS WISHING TO CALL AT ILOILO CITY ARE ADVISED TO READ THE FULL TEXT OF ILOILO CITY EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 050 AND CONTACT THE PORT AUTHORITIES OF THE PORT OF ILOILO CITY FOR FURTHER GUIDANCE.
