**NAVPHIL 049/20 – MINDANAO, W. COAST, PORT OF ZAMBOANGA
– PORT CLOSURE**

IN CONNECTION TO THE PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION NO. 922 DECLARING A STATE OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY THROUGHOUT THE PHILIPPINES AND ZAMBOANGA CITY EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. BCC 552-2020, THE PORT OF ZAMBOANGA WILL IMPLEMENT THE FOLLOWING RULES:

- 1. ALL INCOMING SEA TRANSPORT ARE SUSPENDED EFFECTIVE 12:00 NOON OF 16 MARCH 2020 AND WILL BE IN EFFECT UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE. THE DOMESTIC SEA TRANSPORT OF CARGOES AND OUTGOING PASSENGER SHIPS IS EXCLUDED FROM THE SUSPENSION.**
- 2. ALL PASSENGER VESSELS, ESPECIALLY THOSE COMING FROM MALAYSIA, AND NON-CONVENTIONAL VESSELS ARE PROHIBITED FROM ENETRING THE PORT OF ZAMBOANGA.**
- 3. CARGO VESSELS ARE ALLOWED TO UNLOAD THEIR CARGOES BUT THE CREW MEMBERS OF SAID VESSELS ARE PROHIBITED TO DISEMBARK FROM 15 MARCH 2020 TO 15 APRIL 2020.**

ALL SHIPS/WATERCRAFTS ARE ADVISED TO TAKE NOTE OF THE INFORMATION AND ABIDE BY THE RULES SET BY THE PHILIPPINE GOVERNMENT TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID19.

MASTERS OF VESSELS WISHING TO CALL AT ZAMBOANGA CITY ARE ADVISED TO READ THE FULL TEXT OF ZAMBOANGA CITY EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. BCC 552-2020 AND CONTACT THE PORT AUTHORITIES OF PORT OF ZAMBOANGA FOR FURTHER GUIDANCE.
